

Pre-registration is required by Wednesday, August 30, 2011. There is no entry fee for the Trapper Days Parade.

The parade starts promptly at 10 am. Check-in starts at 7 am, and you must check in prior to 9:30 am. Access to Denver Avenue will be very limited after 8 am. To access the check-in area take Hwy. 85 N to 14th Ave., then South to 12th and Denver (Please follow the signs.) You will receive your lineup number at check-in.

The route is 12 blocks long and starts at 12th Street and Denver Avenue and ends at 2nd and Main. Staging and de-staging is in the open area north of 9th and Main St.

RULES

- ~Motor vehicles must be decorated
- ~Walkers may hand out items; but, nothing can be thrown at the crowd. If violated, you may be asked to exit the parade
- ~Black powder guns may be fired only in "parade mode"
- ~"Burn outs" will not be tolerated
- ~The contact person on this form is responsible for all participants in their entry

PARADE AWARD CRITERIA

Must display Trapper Days "Settlers Heritage" theme to qualify for awards. 1st Place in each category will be awarded \$25 and a Certificate, 2nd and 3rd Places will receive a Certificate.

CATEGORIES:

Commercial Entry: Any form of entry used to advertise a business, follows the theme and is appealing to the crowd.

Mounted Group: Any group on horseback.

Horse Drawn Vehicle: Any vehicle or float pulled by a horse or horses.

Classic Car: Any car, truck, tractor, military or other antique vehicle older than 1970.

Civic Entry: Any form of entry sponsored by a non-profit civic group or community service group.

Bands: Marching or other.

Schools: Any school float or other type of entry.

Creative Entry: All Creative entries that do not fall in the above categories.

Spirit of the Parade: Best Use of Theme.

Grand Marshall Award: Chosen by the Grand Marshal prior to the parade.
